Dear Resident

West Midlands Interchange – upcoming construction works in Calf Heath

I am writing to provide you with information on our upcoming programme of highway works related to the construction of the West Midlands Interchange Development.

Vicarage Road roundabout construction

We will shortly be starting construction of a new roundabout on Vicarage Road, which will provide access to the development. To complete the roundabout construction, we will need to close a section of Vicarage Road and transfer road users to a temporary route between Straight Mile and Stable Lane, which we have constructed adjacent to the existing carriageway.

This temporary route means we can carry out the work without diverting traffic onto smaller local roads that are not suitable for high volumes of vehicles, particularly HGV's.

Traffic will be switched onto the temporary route overnight on **Tuesday 21 October**. The temporary road will remain in use until the roundabout construction is complete in **Summer 2026**.

Please note, there will be a **30mph speed limit** in place on the temporary route for the safety of road users. Clear signage and road markings will be in place to guide road users through the new layout.

Due to the nature of the works, we will also need to include sections of traffic management south of Straight Mile to allow new services to be connected into the existing substation. This will be periodic throughout the duration of the work.

Stable Lane 11kV power cable installation


As part of the new development, National Grid will be installing a new underground 11kV power cable along Stable Lane. This will involve digging a trench, placing the cable, and then reinstating the road surface once work is complete.

To ensure the safety of residents and our workforce, Stable Lane will be closed from **Monday 17 November to Friday 5 December**. Access to properties will be maintained and a map of our working area and diversion route can be seen on the next page.

Our working hours will be 8am to 6pm, Monday to Friday. There may be some occasions where we will need to work on Saturdays. Where this is required, our working hours will be from 9am to 1pm.

We would like to reassure you that Winvic and all involved in the project will ensure any disruption to road users and local businesses is minimised. Please be aware you may see our workforce on site up to one hour before and one hour after these times to set up and secure our equipment.
