West Midlands Interchange – A5 access roundabout construction

I am writing to provide you with information on our upcoming programme of highway works related to the construction of the West Midlands Interchange Development.

As part of this programme, we will shortly be starting construction of a new roundabout on the A5 Watling Street between M6 J12 and A449/A5 Gailey Roundabout. The new roundabout will provide access to the development once it's complete. The works will be delivered in phases, with completion expected in early 2027.

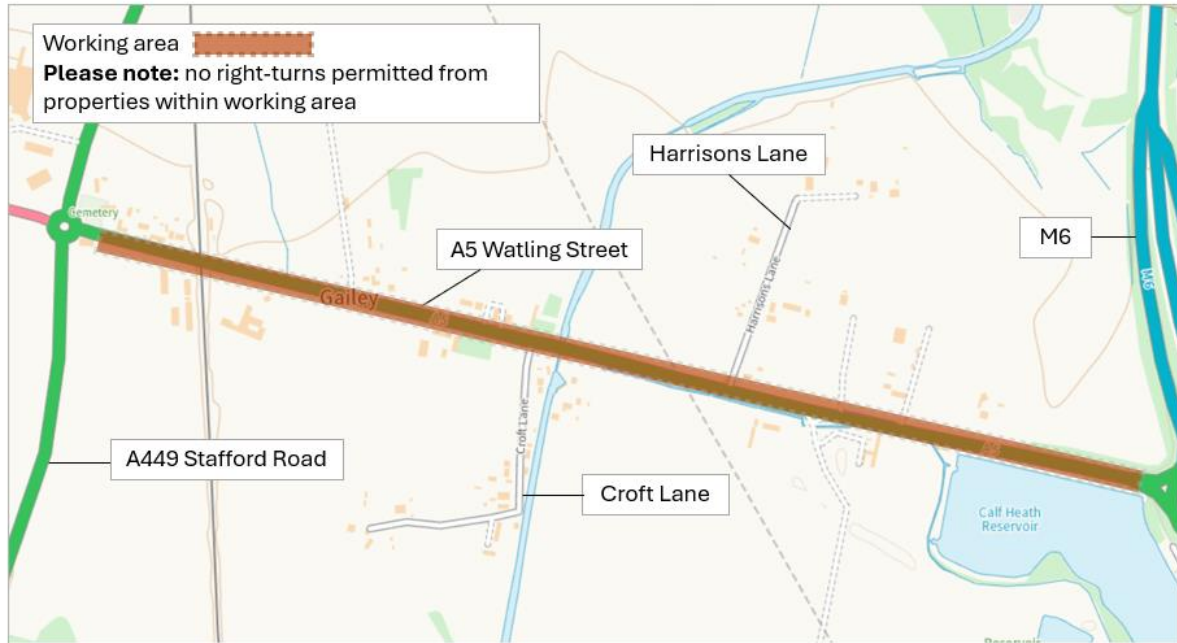
The first phase of works will begin on **Monday 12 January** and will include the installation of narrow lanes on the eastbound and westbound carriageways. These narrow lanes are required to safely facilitate the construction of the new eastbound footway/cycleway and the roundabout, and will remain in place for the duration of the works. A temporary 30mph speed limit will also be in place.

A map of our working area can be seen on the following page. Our working hours will be 8am to 6pm, Monday to Friday. There may be some occasions where we will need to work on Saturdays during this phase. Where this is required, our working hours will be from 9am to 1pm

Access to properties will be maintained at all times. **Please note, to ensure the safety of road users and our workforce, vehicles exiting properties within the working area will not be permitted to turn right.**

Other traffic management required for the roundabout construction will include some full road closures. These are expected to take place later in the programme, and we will provide further details well in advance of these works.
